NSTRA MEMBERS - Important things to remember!

Reminders – check back often!

National trials are the responsibility of the National Officers with input from the Board of Directors and the local co-chairs of national trials. Criteria for entry, which may be subject to change, for the original 5 National Trials is available in the reference section of the Rule Book beginning on page 41, Section 11. If a particular national trial is subject to changes in the entry criteria, there will be notice provided on the official entry form, in the magazine, on the national website, and/or by email if available.

To enter a national trial, you may submit a hard copy official entry form and payment, OR you may scan and email an official entry form with payment information, OR you may send by facsimile and official entry form with payment information, OR you may enter and pay on-line on the website. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Please note that additional new national trials may be added from time to time and do not yet appear in the current Rule Book. Please contact your National Officer Representative or the National Office staff for additional information regarding such trials. The current list of National Trials is as follows:

QUAIL FOREVER, formerly known as Quail Invitational. This is a revolving trial generally held in February.

TRIAL OF CHAMPIONS. This trial is held in Amo, Indiana, in April.

UKC PERFORMANCE TRIAL. This trial is a revolving trial generally held in June.

PURINA ENDURANCE CLASSIC. This is revolving trial generally held in September:

DOG OF THE YEAR. This trial is held in Amo, Indiana, in October.

NATIONAL AMATEUR

CHAMPIONSHIP is a new trial (Dec 2020). The intent is to be a revolving trial.

TOP PERFORMANCE AWARD:

To be eligible:

*Dogs must have at least 20 open points accumulated in weekend trials between June 1 through May 31 of the applicable year. Once a dog is eligible, a schedule of scoring is applied based on the results at regional elimination trials and National Trials

*The Performance Trial will be the beginning national trial each year, even if it ends prior to June 1 in order to keep the number of national trials the same each year.

*The Regional Elimination trial results used in calculating Top Performance Awards is the regularly scheduled regional elimination championship in the gualifying year/season (only one regional can count per year). Regionals scheduled or rescheduled to be held after June 1 will apply to the previous year. Each regional elimination will have a point value of 600 points. The value will drop 25 points per placement until the last dog or points run out (1 – 600, 2 – 575, 3 – 550, etc.). The placement for the regional eliminations is determined by the score of the last round in which the dog ran. In addition, 100 points will be awarded to the Champion, 75 for the second-place dog, 50 for the third and 25 for fourth.

*The National Trials results are calculated as follows: A dog must place in the top 32 dogs to receive a qualifying score from that trial. Each national trial will have a point value of 800 points. The value will drop 25 points per placement throughout the Saturday cut (1 - 800, 2 - 775, 3 - 750, etc.). The placement for the national trial is determined by the score of the last round in which the dog ran. In addition, 100 bonus points will be awarded to the Champion, 75 for second place, 50 for third and 25 for fourth.

HALL OF FAME NOMINATIONS:

Hall of Fame nominations will be accepted in a rolling calendar throughout the year. Send these nominations to the nation office, or to a national officer no later than March 31 of the year in which a dog is to be considered. Nominations of dogs to the NSTRA Hall of Fame are NOT "carried over" to following years. Plainly stated, a dog that does not get elected to the Hall of Fame in the year nominated must be re-submitted in order to be considered for election. The National Officers, in concert with the Board of Directors, make selections to the Hall of Fame each April.

TRIAL SCHEDULES:

Fall/winter trial schedules are due in the office by May 1. Spring/summer trial schedules are due in the office by Nov. 1. All trials must be published on the website 4 weeks prior to their running.

SANCTION FEES:

Trial sanction fees are required BEFORE a trial packet is mailed and before a trial may be "approved" in the system. Please pay all sanction fees at least 4 weeks prior to your trial date to ensure prompt mailing of the packet and to ensure that the trial may be drawn in a timely manner.

TRIAL REPORTS:

Trial reports and results should be entered into the trial draw system as soon as possible after a trial and no later than 10 days after the trial date. Overall results will not be approved until the reporting is complete. First place points and championships will not be confirmed or awarded until the reporting is complete. (This includes receipt of all registration paperwork for placing dogs.)

HOME REGION:

Members requesting a change of Home Region must do so, in writing, through the National Office between the dates of October 1 and January 1. *Exception: A member who permanently relocates to within the boundaries of a Region, other than their Home Region, may make written application to the NSTRA office at any time to request a change in their Home Region.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIPS:

Associate memberships are available to members' spouses and children 18 years and under, still living at home. There must be at least one regular paid membership in the household to qualify. Associate members have the same rights as regular members with respect to participating in field trials (e.g., owning dogs, handling dogs, judging, bird planting, etc.). Associate member may not vote in any regional or national elections including rule or by-law changes, they cannot hold an office, and they do not receive a magazine.

RULE CHANGES:

Proposed rule changes or new additions shall be submitted sixty (60) days prior to the first day of the Trial of Champions and/or the Dog of the Year trial.

CONSTITUTION/BY-LAW CHANGES:

All proposed amendments to the Constitution and By-laws shall be submitted to the National Officers at least ninety (90) days prior to the first day of the Trial of Champions and/or the Dog of the Year trial.

REGION HIGH POINT:

Points earned in the qualifying rounds of a Regional Elimination or a Championship trial DO count towards the region's high point competition. Points earned in the finals of above trials DO NOT count towards the region's high point.

OWNERSHIP CHANGE:


Once a dog takes a NSTRA placement, any subsequent ownership changes must be sent to the NSTRA office. Please send a copy of new registration papers with the new owners' names to the office. The date of transfer will be the date shown on the registration papers.

FIRST TIME PLACEMENTS:

The National Office now requires a copy of the dog's registration certificate for first time placements. This can either be submitted by the owner or the trial chairman. We will accept copies by fax (317-839-4197), e-mail (office@nstra.org), or a photocopy by regular mail.

NSTRA DISTINGUISHED MEMBERS:

The NSTRA Distinguished Members award honors those extraordinary men and women whose contributions and achievements significantly helped develop, or continued to improve, the National Shoot to Retrieve Field Trial Association, Inc. This award will be presented annually at the Dog of the Year banquet. Nominations may be submitted at any time to the staff at the national office, to a National Officer, or to the current chair of the Distinguished Members Committee. A short description of the individual and their contributions to NSTRA should be sent to the national office. A picture of the individual should be included, if available. Contact the NSTRA office for a list of criteria. The committee will review all Nominations and verify contributions. Decisions will be made not only by the information submitted but by any other information collected. The committee will make their decision by the April Board of Directors' meeting. A permanent plague will be located at the NSTRA office with a smaller plaque awarded to the individual or their family if deceased.

POSITIVE TRAINING METHODS FOR PUPPIES

To get next level performance from sporting breeds like Labs, GSPs, and all breeds in between, use positive training methods when your puppy is young. This training method rewards puppies for successfully completing a task. Once a puppy understands the kind of behavior that gets him a reward he'll want to do more of it. Here are four ways to get started using positive **training with your puppy.**

PICK YOUR REWARD

In positive training sessions, a reward is used to show a puppy he has done the right thing. Puppies respond well to a variety of different rewards, but food is most commonly used. Consider using treats specifically designed for training. These treats are usually low in calories to promote a healthy weight. Some training treats contain additional nutrients like DHA to support healthy brain function.

Praise is also used in positive training and can be a kind word delivered in a happy, upbeat tone, a pat on the back or a rub on the belly. Read your dog to understand which reward he responds to best.

Using positive training methods helps build a lifelong, ready-for-anything bond with your puppy.

KEEP TRAINING SESSIONS SHORT

From maintaining steadiness on point to running marks and blinds, to casting in fields and covers, sporting breed puppies have a lot to learn. Between 8 and 20 weeks of age, a puppy's mind is like a sponge, and that's the time to establish a solid, positive training foundation. Since puppies readily absorb new information, daily training is super important.

But a puppy's attention span is short. For the most productive results, use 5-to-10-minute

training sessions, two- or three-times throughout the day. After each session, let your puppy play and have some fun. After that he'll want to take a nap. Once he's refreshed, tackle another training session followed by more play and another nap.

USE SIMPLE AND CONSISTENT COMMANDS

Puppies respond best to simplicity and consistency. Use short, easy to understand commands and stick with them. For recall, say 'come,' and say it every time. Shifting from 'come' to 'come here' to 'come over here' confuses puppies. Confused puppies don't understand what you want them to do. Repetition makes the master, so focus on one command during each training session. Keep commands simple, consistent, and upbeat, and reward your puppy each time he gets it right. Once he has mastered the task at hand, move on to the next command.

TIMING IS IMPORTANT

With positive training, the timing of a treat or praise is critically important. The reward should come immediately upon successful completion of the task. If time passes before the reward is given, then the puppy doesn't know what he's being rewarded for. If using treats, keep them easily accessible and deliver one precisely each time your puppy properly completes the task.

Positive training methods are a great way to develop a bold, confident sporting dog. Since it can take puppies numerous attempts to master a task, be mindful of your energy and tone throughout each training session. Stay consistent, patient, and upbeat, and your puppy will look forward to learning new skills.



In Memoriam



Lyle H. Jordan

Lyle was a long-time member of NSTRA and served on the Illinois Region Board of Directors as well as a NSTRA National President. Lyle was instrumental in helping set up the Illinois Region. His grounds around Assumption were the fields for many weekend trials along with regional eliminations. His favorite dog, Rebel, was a 1 time NSTRA Champion (only 1 point away from a 2X) and was a real point of pride for him. He met many friends during his dog trialing years and spoke fondly of them in the years beyond his trial days. His time in NSTRA provided years of stories and good memories that he treasured.



Charles Ronald "Ronnie" Robertson,

86, of Danville, IN, passed away October 26th, 2021. He was born July 10, 1935 in Linton, Indiana to the late Charles N. Robertson and Lillian B. (Cunningham) Robertson. His childhood was filled with friends and family sharing good times fishing and hunting. He always had hunting dogs and other "pets", including ponies, a goat and a calf. He graduated from Linton Stockton High School, where he proved to be a powerhouse on the football team.

After graduation, Ron proudly served his country in the U.S. Marine Corp 1953-1956. While home on leave from Okinawa, Japan, he met Wyvonna Booker. Wy's co-worker, Bonnie, and her fiancé, Philip, who happened to be Ronnie's cousin, introduced them on a double date in September and they were married December 3, 1955. They lived



One of his proudest moments was when Anheuser-Busch came calling to purchase one of his young Clydes. Whenever he was in the area, he could often be found "behind the scenes" at Grant's Farms or Busch Gardens Tampa Bay, enjoying every moment with the Clydesdales. (A found memory of Shelby Albert's was riding on Ronnie's wagon while showing his Clydes at the Illinois State Fair at the age of 5 years old.) Ronnie had a soft spot for kids and had helped more than one with their dog at the Amo Club. Another year he trailered his horses to Florida where he participated in the Florida State Fair and the Ocala Horse Fair. Several NSTRA members attended both events and watched as he and Wy received numerous placements.

Survivors include his loving wife of nearly 66 years, Wyvonna Robertson of Danville, IN; children, Rhonda (Larry) Angrick, Rick (Karen) Robertson; 3 grandchildren, 3 step grandchildren and 5 step great grandchildren, his treasured nephews and countless friends.



HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN DOG PAW BALM

To some dogs (especially breeds built for cold weather), there's nothing more exciting than a romp around a snowy yard after a winter storm. But icy conditions of the yard or cold pavements can be damaging a pet's paws.

The national breed club for the Newfoundland, a large breed built for wintery work, shared with AKC a DIY paw balm recipe taken from Frugally Sustainable, which the club recommended to its Facebook followers.

Get it here:

RECIPE: DIY PAW BALM

Supplies

- 21-24 standard lip balm tubes OR 6 1-oz. tins
- a small digital kitchen scale, optional
- small pot or double boiler

Ingredients

- 2 oz. (approx. 2 tbsp.) olive, sunflower, or sweet almond
- 2 oz. (approx. 2 tbsp.) coconut oil (buy on amazon)
- 1 oz. (approx. 1 tbsp.) shea butter (buy on amazon)
- 4 tsp. beeswax (buy on amazon)

Method

1. In a small pot or double boiler over low heat melt the oils, shea butter, and beeswax. Stir continuously until all is melted and well blended.

- 2. Carefully pour the mixture into lip balm tubes and/or tins. (buy on amazon)
- 3. Let them cool on the counter until hard.
- 4. Cap and label.
- 5. Keep away from extreme heat.
- 6. Apply the balm as a preventive treatment or to help soften dry paw pads or noses. Use within 1 to 2 years.

OTHER PAW PROTECTION METHODS

Booties: Yes, your dog might look a little silly, but dog boots are actually quite effective at protecting his feet from snow and ice as well as de-icing products, which can make your dog sick if he licks it off his paws. These products can also burn pads and the sensitive skin between their toes, causing great pain and distress. "The boots my dogs wear in winter if temps fall into the single digits or below zero come from Ruffwear," says Roxanne Hawn, AKC Family Dog grooming columnist. Another popular brand is Pawz, available at most major pet stores.

Trimming: Keeping the paw hair short is also important as it will prevent snow and ice from forming balls that can lead to chaffing, chapping, and even cuts. Trim the hairs around the outside of your dog's paw so that it doesn't extend past the boundaries of the paw. You can also use a small battery-operated trimmer to shorten the hair between the paw pads. (Contact a pro if you have a fidgety dog or don't feel comfortable doing this.)

Wiping: If you choose not to use booties on your dog, be sure to wipe his feet before he comes inside to ensure that de-icing products (like salt) have been removed along with any ice balls that might have formed.


