

The report and photos can be sent by email or uploaded to DropBox.

"Limit to weekend regional trialing in magazine will be 3 paragraphs - 300-400 words and 4 pictures".

NSTRA MEMBERS - Important things to remember!

Reminders - check back often!

National trials are the responsibility of the National Officers with input from the Board of Directors and the local co-chairs of national trials. Criteria for entry, which may be subject to change, for the original 5 National Trials is available in the reference section of the Rule Book beginning on page 41, Section 11. If a particular national trial is subject to changes in the entry criteria, there will be notice provided on the official entry form, in the magazine, on the national website, and/or by email if available.

To enter a national trial, you may submit a hard copy official entry form and payment, OR you may scan and email an official entry form with payment information, OR you may send by facsimile and official entry form with payment information, OR you may enter and pay on-line on the website. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Please note that additional new national trials may be added from time to time and do not yet appear in the current Rule Book. Please contact your National Officer Representative or the National Office staff for additional information regarding such trials. The current list of National Trials is as follows:

GARMIN INVITATIONAL CHAMPI-ONSHIP TRIAL Formerly known as Quail Forever. This is a revolving trial generally held in

TRIAL OF CHAMPIONS. This trial is held in Amo, Indiana, in April.

NATIONAL AMATEUR TRIAL OF CHAMPIONS. This trial is held in Amo, Indiana, in April.

UKC PERFORMANCE TRIAL. This trial is a revolving trial generally held in June.

PURINA ENDURANCE CLASSIC. This is revolving trial generally held in September:

DOG OF THE YEAR. This trial is held in Amo, Indiana, in October.

TOP **PERFORMANCE AWARD:**

To be eligible:

*Dogs must have at least 20 open points accumulated in weekend trials between June 1 through May 31 of the applicable year. Once a dog is eligible, a schedule of scoring is applied based on the results at regional elimination trials and National Trials

*The Performance Trial will be the beginning national trial each year, even if it ends prior to June 1 in order to keep the number of national trials the same each year.

*The Regional Elimination trial results used in calculating Top Performance Awards is the regularly scheduled regional elimination championship

in the qualifying year/season (only one regional can count per year). Regionals scheduled or rescheduled to be held after June 1 will apply to the previous year. Each regional elimination will have a point value of 600 points. The value will drop 25 points per placement until the last dog or points run out (1 - 600, 2 - 575, 3 - 550, etc.). The placement for the regional eliminations is determined by the score of the last round in which the dog ran. In addition, 100 points will be awarded to the Champion, 75 for the second-place dog, 50 for the third and 25 for fourth.

*The National Trials results are calculated as follows: A dog must place in the top 32 dogs to receive a qualifying score from that trial. Each national trial will have a point value of 800 points. The value will drop 25 points per placement throughout the Saturday cut (1 – 800, 2 - 775, 3 – 750, etc.). The placement for the national trial is determined by the score of the last round in which the dog ran. In addition, 100 bonus points will be awarded to the Champion, 75 for second place, 50 for third and 25 for fourth.

HALL OF FAME NOMINATIONS:

Hall of Fame nominations will be accepted in a rolling calendar throughout the year. Send these nominations to the nation office, or to a national officer no later than March 31 of the year in which a dog is to be considered. Nominations of dogs to the NSTRA Hall of Fame are NOT "carried over" to following years. Plainly stated, a dog that does not get elected to the Hall of Fame in the year nominated must be re-submitted in order to be considered for election. The National Officers, in concert with the Board of Directors, make selections to the Hall of Fame each April.

TRIAL SCHEDULES:

Fall/winter trial schedules are due in the office by May 1. Spring/summer trial schedules are due in the office by Nov. 1. All trials must be published on the website 4 weeks prior to their running.

SANCTION FEES:

Trial sanction fees are required BEFORE a trial packet is mailed and before a trial may be "approved" in the system. Please pay all sanction fees at least 4 weeks prior to your trial date to ensure prompt mailing of the packet and to ensure that the trial may be drawn in a timely manner.

TRIAL REPORTS:

Trial reports and results should be entered into the trial draw system as soon as possible after a trial and no later than 10 days after the trial date. Overall results will not be approved until the reporting is complete. First place points and championships will not be confirmed or awarded until the reporting is complete. (This includes receipt of all registration paperwork for placing dogs.)

HOME REGION:

Members requesting a change of Home Region must do so, in writing, through the National Office between the dates of October 1 and January 1..

*Exception: A member who permanently relocates to within the boundaries of a Region, other than their Home Region, may make written application to the NSTRA office at any time to request a change in their Home Region.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIPS:

Associate memberships are available to members' spouses and children 18 years and under, still living at home. There must be at least one regular paid membership in the household to qualify. Associate members have the same rights as regular members with respect to participating in field trials (e.g., owning dogs, handling dogs, judging, bird planting, etc.). Associate member may not vote in any regional or national elections including rule or bylaw changes, they cannot hold an office, and they do not receive a magazine.

RULE CHANGES:

Proposed rule changes or new additions shall be submitted sixty (60) days prior to the first day of the Trial of Champions and/or the Dog of the Year trial.

CONSTITUTION/BY-LAW CHANGES:

All proposed amendments to the

Constitution and By-laws shall be submitted to the National Officers at least ninety (90) days prior to the first day of the Trial of Champions and/or the Dog of the Year trial.

REGION HIGH POINT:

Points earned in the qualifying rounds of a Regional Elimination or a Championship trial DO count towards the region's high point competition. Points earned in the finals of above trials DO NOT count towards the region's high point.

OWNERSHIP CHANGE:

Once a dog takes a NSTRA placement, any subsequent ownership changes must be sent to the NSTRA office. Please send a copy of new registration papers with the new owners' names to the office. The date of transfer will be the date shown on the registration papers.

UNREGISTERED DOGS:

As of June 1, 2022 a dog cannot run in a NSTRA trial without a system-generated dog profile or record. A trial coordinator cannot create the record. National staff or officers can only create the record once registration papers are received in the NSTRA office. In addition, there remain many "unapproved" dogs in the system. Unapproved dogs shall not be entered to run in trials until proper paperwork is received and appropriate action to create the record is completed. This can either be submitted by the owner or the trial chairman. We will accept copies by fax (317-839-4197), e-mail (office@nstra.org), or a photocopy by regular mail.

NSTRA DISTINGUISHED MEMBERS:

The NSTRA Distinguished Members award honors those extraordinary men and women whose contributions and achievements significantly helped develop, or continued to improve, the National Shoot to Retrieve Field Trial Association, Inc. This award will be presented annually at the Dog of the Year banquet. Nominations may be submitted at any time to the staff at the national office, to a National Officer, or to the current chair of the Distinguished Members Committee. A short description of the individual and their contributions to NSTRA should be sent to the national office. A picture of the individual should be included, if

available. Contact the NSTRA office for a list of criteria. The committee will review all Nominations and verify contributions.

Decisions will be made not only by the information submitted but by any other information collected. The committee will make their decision by the April Board of Directors' meeting. A permanent plaque will be located at the NSTRA office with a smaller plaque awarded to the individual or their family if deceased.

NSTRA TRIAL DATES and QUALIFYING DATES

2025 Purina Endurance Classic Dickinson, ND September 3-6, 2025

The number of dogs in the trial shall be a maximum of one hundred twenty-eight. Region quotas will be determined based on number of trials held in each region June 1st to May 31st.

Entry into this trial is based on all open points earned within a dog's home region and placement points earned from qualifying rounds of a National Trial during the period of June 1, 2024 through May 31, 2025.

2025 Dog of the Year Amo, IN October 22-25, 2025 Must run in 2025 regional

2026 Garmin Invitational Lake Wales, FL February 25-28, 2026

Qualification: Nov 1, 2024 through October 31, 2025 – All open points earned during the time frame except points earned from placements in the top 4 of a national championship trial or regional championship trial. Qualifying rounds do count.

Entry is based on the number of points.

Trial of Champions Amo, Indiana April 22-25, 2026

Championship and is at least a 1x champion by February 1 of thecurrent year. A dog can be a paid standby for this trial by achieving their Championship between Feb 1, 2026 and March 31, 2026.

Amateur Trial of Champions Amo, Indiana April 22-25, 2026


Amateur Championship by February 1, 2026, and is NOT an open champion. A dog can be paid standby for this trial by achieving their Amateur Championship between February 1, 2026 and March 31, 2026.

2026 UKC Performance classic. May 27-30, 2026.

Points earned from April 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026.

Dogs will be eligible to enter the trial based on open points earned from weekend trials only. All open points will count except those points earned during qualifying and final rounds of the National Championship and Regional Championship Trials.





2025 Purina Top Performance WINNER

KICKAPOO'S SAMUEL ADAMS 3050 points ETIENNE LAVOIE

Owned and handled by Etienne Lavoie of the Central Canada region. Adams is a 5-year-old English Setter from Smith's Shadow Oak Caffrey and Kickapoo Sioux Too. He finished the season with 26 weekend points. He started by a 15th place at the UKC Performance Classic. The following national trial, Purina Endurance, he ends up first runner up by only 1.8 points to the champion. For the Dog of the Year he was 9th and for the Garmin Invitational he got the 11th. To close this year, he ends up second runner up at the Central Canada Regional Elimination. His consistency was remarkable, we're proud of him. Adams finished first with 3050 points for the Top Performance, with a total of 136 lifetime points including 95 first place points.



PURINA TOP PERFORMANCE AWARD

BY MARII YN CUNNINGHAM

The Top Performance Award is sponsored each year by Purina with the top 4 dogs receiving an eloquent trophy plus the Purina Top Performance jacket.

Dogs must have at least 20 open points from June 1 through May 31 for the applicable year to be eligible. Weekend trials only. From there, the award will be based on national trials and regional eliminations.

The Performance Trial will be the beginning national trial each year, even if it ends prior to June 1st in order to keep the number of nationals the same each year.

The Regional Elimination trial will be based on regularly scheduled regionals for each year and only one regional can count per year. Regionals scheduled or rescheduled to be held after June 1 will apply to the previous year.

For National trials, a dog must make the top 32 to receive a qualifying score (10/20). Each national trial will have a point value of 800 points and the value will drop 25 points per placement throughout the Saturday cut (1st - 800, 2nd - 775, 3rd - 750, etc.). In addition, 100 bonus points will be awarded to the Champion, 75 for the 1st runner up, 50 for the 2nd runner up and 25 for the 3rd runner up.

Each Regional Elimination will have a point value of 600 points. The value will drop 25 points per placement until the last dog or points run out (1st – 600, 2nd – 575, 3rd – 550, etc.). In addition, 100 points will be awarded to the Champion, 75 for the second-place dog, 50 for third and 25 for fourth. **

The placement for Regional Eliminations and National Trials is determined by the score of the last round in which the dog ran.

This change makes each National Trial count the same amount as per the regions' request. It also allows points to be given to each dog in the Saturday morning cut as per the original suggested format. It will weigh the two trials that take 32 to Saturday with a greater percent for mid-range dogs but those are the trials that a dog must make an extra cut on Saturday, so it is relevant. It also weighs the final fours more.

This change makes each regional count the same so larger regions will not receive an advantage.

In the event of a tie for the top four placements, the tie shall be broken this way:

- 1. National wins
- 2. Final four placements
- 3. Region wins
- 4. Total points for the year

The winner of the award for the 2024-2025 time frame was Kickapoo's Samuel Adams - a standing tall orange and white English Setter male. Adams is owned by Etienne Lavoie -Central Canada Region. Adams is a 7x NSTRA Champion - sire Smith's Shadow Oak Caffrey and dam - Kickapoo Sioux Too. At this point in his career, he has 136 total lifetime points with 26 weekend points. Adams totaled points were 3050 points; placements follow: 2024 UKC Performance Classic 15th - 450 points, 2024 Purina Endurance Classic 2nd - 850 points; 2024 DOY 9th - 600 points; 2025 Garmin Invitational 11th - 550 points; and 2025 CC Regional 3rd - 600 points. The Lavoie Kennel made each Championship trial during the time frame and that's a lot of traveling - especially considering they are members of the Central Canada Region. Congratulations to Adams, Etienne and Manon for a great Top Performance season.

Crosswind's Envy A Trip To The Train Station - Rip, German Shorthair Pointer owned by Sara Thorne and Brandon Ralston from the II Region; was the 1st runner up in the Purina Top Performance Award, taking 1st place at Dog of the Year and 1st place at the first ever Garmin sponsored Garmin Invitational, winning back to back national trials in the 2024-2025 trial season, handled by Brandon Ralston and accumulating 1800 points . He took 3rd place at the Illinois Regional Trial gathering 2400 total Top Performance Points with 42 weekend points. Handled by Brandon Ralston and Sara Thorne, his weekend points included winning Illinois Region High Point Dog and High Point Dog at the 4-day Shriner's Children's Hospital Benefit Trial; he added 3 open championships, earning his 5th open championship, ending the season just 2 points shy of his 6th open championship. Rip is from 7x NSTRA Champion Crosswind Micro Chip and Somers Ama-Zing Grace. Quite a year for this young, phenomenal GSP, Sara and the Ralstons.

Placing 3rd in the competition was **Black Magic Bobbi Sue** owned by Lori Sprick (IL)

and handled along with husband, Kevin. Bobbi is a 6x NSTRA Champion with 134 lifetime points. Her sire is 13x CH Crosswind Jim and dam - 9x CH Double R Liz. Bobbi had 23 weekend points and 2200 Top Performance points. TP points as follows: 2024 UKC Performance Classic placing 1st with 900 points, 2024 Purina Endurance Classic placing 23 with 250 points, 2025 Garmin Invitational 18th with 375 points, 2025 Illinois Regional 13th with 300 points and 18th at the 2025 TOC Championship with 375 points. This past year has been a team effort with Kevin running her in the fall, and Lori handling when Kevin was unable to do so, due to his back problems. Lori added that their thanks also goes to Brandon Ralston running her while Kevin was recovering from his back surgery and helped her clinch her spot. Lori says "She's just Bobbi and does her Bobbi thing!" NSTRA salutes this fine young stylish black and white pointer, Kevin and Lori.

The 4th place finisher was Kickapoo's Ghost River Gold, 2 1/2 year old orange and white English Setter male owned and handled by Etienne Lavoie, CC Region. Ghost is from Smith's Shadow Oak Caffrey and dam - Kickapoo Sioux Too. He is a 4x NSTRA Ch with 80 lifetime points and 22 weekend points. Etienne was proud to have 2 dogs in the top four of this time frame. Ghost had 2125 points which included 14th with 475 points during the 2024 DOY trial, 6th - 675 points at the 2025 Garmin Invitational, 22nd at the 2025 TOC Championship - 275 points and 1st at the CC Regional Elimination gathering 700 points clinching the 4th place win. Ghost is a stylish young setter heading for another remarkable season with Etienne. Our congratulations go out to this fine team.

5th was **Ragin Cajun Nike** –owner/handler Wayne Fishburn (IN) Nike is a 2 ½ year old German Shorthair female from TC's Get Lucky Lou and Ragin Cajun Athena. Nike had 23 weekend points and 2075 total points. They follow: 2024 Purina Endurance Classic – 6th place – 675 points; 2024 DOY Trial – 31st -- 50 points; 2025 Indiana Region Elimination – 3rd – 600 points; 2025 TOC Championship – 4th –750 points. At only 2 ½ years old this young shorthair has already displayed her ability to earn points at each NSTRA Championship venue she has attended. NSTRA congratulates this fine shorthair and owner/handler Wayne.

Sixth place was Bluegrass Ramblin Gambler (Ace), Brittany male, owned by Clay Little from the KY region. Ace accumulated 20 weekend points during the TP time frame. He is from Blue Grass Ramblin Man and K Nines Bluegrass Nose Knows; and is a 4x NSTRA Champion with 90 lifetime points. The Little Family, Mark, Clay and Jack attend many of the NSTRA functions and trials and have made the Brittany name one to be reckoned with. Ace placed 8th at the 2024 UKC Performance Classic picking up 625 points, was 5th at the 2024 DOY Championship earning 700 points, was 29th at the 2025 TOC Championship - 100 points and was 3rd at the Kentucky Regional picking up 600 points with a total of 2025 final points. Congratulations to Clay, Ace and the Little Family for another fine showing.

Number 7th on the Top Performance Award was Oles Runninringnecks Bucknaked "Shilo", a 3 ½ year old German Shorthair female. Her Sire is Rising Sun Buck Naked and dam Ole's Cuttin Loose Bailey. Shilo is a 4x NSTRA Champion with 81 lifetime points. She is owned by Dale Roberts of the WTX/OK Region. Shilo earned 27 region points and started on her TP award with 16th place at the 2024 UKC Performance Classic - 425 points. She won the 2024 Purina Endurance Classic accumulating 900 points and followed with a 2nd place during the WTX/OK Region adding 650 points which amounted to a total of 1975 TP points. Shilo is a snappy Shorthair in the field and a tough competitor. Our congratulations to Shilo, Dale and Carmen for a super year.

Tomoka's Smokin Patch, 2 year old English Setter male, owned by Greg Wood, Kentucky. Tomoka's Smokin Mike (15x NSTRA Ch) is the sire with Sanders Smokin Hot Mess the dam. Patch is a 5x Ch with 104 lifetime points and 24 region points. The 1725 TP points consisted of 23 points at the 2024 UKC Performance Classic totaling 250 points; 20th at the 2024 Purina Endurance Classic with 325 points; 13th during the 2025 TOC Championship receiving 500 points; and was 2nd earning 650 points at the Kentucky Regional Elimination. Patch was High Point Dog of Kentucky, Runner-up during the Jim Harmon Memorial trial and won the Jim Turner Memorial trial. 





In Memory of Darlene Donovan

The NSTRA community mourns the passing of Darlene Donovan, who passed away peacefully at her home in Belgrade, Montana, on September 8, surrounded by her husband Mark, her son Kyle, her brothers, and her cherished family.

While Darlene spent her career as a clerk with the U.S. Postal Service, her true life's passion was her family and her dogs. Her journey in NSTRA was always side by side with her husband, Mark who judged and ran dogs, and son, Kyle who grew up bird planting. Darlene's greatest joy was found in following her dogs—whether in a field trial or out bird hunting. She spoke often with pride of her family and her dogs, and was fiercely proud of them, celebrating every success and moment together.

Darlene and Mark's first major success came with Montana's Rusty Little Pants ("Rusty"), a 6x NSTRA Champion, who won the 2007 Purina Endurance and was also a Big Sky Regional Champion. Rusty went on to sire Footluce Louie Little Pants ("Louie")—an 8x NSTRA Champion who not only made his mark in the field but also helped Darlene truly learn and love the game of NSTRA.

Louie's legacy lived on through Outlaw Willie Little Pants ("Willie"), who gave Darlene one of her proudest moments: a 3rd place finish at the 2019 Purina Endurance Trial, along with four NSTRA Champion titles. She also enjoyed trialing Loki, a 1x Champion, and Kit, who won the 2024 Big Sky Region Amateur Championship, adding to her long line of canine partners who brought her joy, competition, and companionship.

Because of the insightfulness and dedication that Darlene and Mark put into their line of Brittany's, the "Little Pants" dogs have gone on to leave an indelible mark on the sport. They have sired National Champions, multiple Top 4 NSTRA dogs, multiple Regional Champions, AKC titled dogs, 3x American Brittany Club NSTRA Dog of the Year, NSTRA Hall of Fame-eligible dogs, and many more accolades—a true legacy that continues to shape the future of NSTRA.

Beyond the field, Darlene will be remembered for her warmth and generosity. She had a love of baking, cooking and sewing for her family and friends, and her homemade jam became a signature gift at NSTRA events. Nothing could be store bought when it came to gifts, even in her final days, Darlene was determined to ensure a jar of her jam made it into the 2025 Purina Endurance goody bags—a goal her family helped her fulfill, perfectly capturing her spirit of giving.

Darlene's legacy is one of devotion: to her family, her dogs, her friends in the NSTRA community, and to the sport she loved. She will be deeply missed but fondly remembered every time her friends gather in the field, following bird dogs with the same passion that defined her life.









Amateurs



A few years ago, my friend, Gator Man, from Georgia, and I were taking during a trial. "So, what I think we need to do is set up a way to allow new handlers to get into the sport of NSTRA," he said. "What's wrong with what we have right now?" I said. New guys need to pay their dues. And so the discussion went back and forth.

I recalled my introduction to NSTRA. I saw a small ad in the GON (Georgia Outdoor News), no more than a few lines, that read "More Action Per Acre with your bird dog!" I called the number and was invited to a field trial in North Georgia a few weeks later. It was in a hilly area of the country, and it was raining. They told me they would set out five quail, and another handler and I would have 30 minutes to find and shoot them. The dogs would be scored, and placements given at the end of the day. That was it. The sum total of my briefing.

I distinctly remember thinking, "Five birds in that small field, and I have 30 minutes to find them? Piece of cake!" My dog, Rocket, (Brit/M), and I were accustomed to 2000 acres of briar-covered clearcut in south Georgia. This would be no problem, I thought.

Off the start line, my bracemate, a huge, white Pointer, jumped on Rocket, I can only assume due to some trashtalking between the dogs. We got them separated and off we went to find the birds. I remember Rocket found three birds in the rain. I missed all three, and he chased them down. I don't remember

who the Judge was, but he was telling me all kinds of rules and giving me advice along the way. I assimilated none of the rules because I was busy following the dog and worrying about the score I was going to get for my poor shooting. (I thought I was being judged, too.)

My second brace was a little easier, because I ran against a 5-time Champion dog, a Setter

as I recall. The handler was absolutely a nice and fun guy in the blind as we talked and he learned this was my very first trial. I remember how his face lit up once I divulged that information. Once the brace started, I remember wondering how I ended up behind his dog the entire time? Every time I looked up, it seemed like his dog was on point. We didn't find a bird that time, but everyone was so friendly. That was in 1992.

It took a few years, a few dogs, and a few thousand dollars before I started gathering a couple placements, and then Championships, and finally, Region Championships.

Gator Man said, "Why don't we have new guys compete against new guys? could have them drawn in regular braces, but at the end of the day, they would score against the other new guys that day for placements. Kind of like a trial inside a trial. It would be an "Amateur" category. That way they could learn the game and it would take some pressure off them. Also, it would encourage them to come out and run against the "big boys"." I thought about it and I remember I was very skeptical, but I did say I thought it was a good idea. Truthfully, I thought it would never work. I thought it would be too difficult to administer. Besides, getting crushed for a few years was a great growth opportunity, right? Boy, was I wrong!

Gator Man took his idea to National and it sprouted and flourished. Others joined in and great ideas took root. Slowly, many NSTRA Regions noticed new dogs and handlers. The Open/Amateur Trial became common as new handlers joined the association, and many saw success through the amateur ranks. It was not uncommon to watch a dog take home Open and Amateur points on the same run! That encouragement was the impetus to keep them driving to trials and entering their dogs. Amateur Championships evolved and Amateur National Championship Trial developed. Amateur-only trials evolved with a certain number of Amateur points allowing the amateur dogs to qualify for their Region Elimination Championships and perhaps move on the National Championship Trial in Amo, IN.

The rules and procedures were refined and defined. Another outstanding change to assist new handlers was the Mentorship program. It allowed a seasoned handler (old guy) to walk along with a new handler and assist and give advice throughout the braces. Years of hard won knowledge was passed along in the field, and that allowed the new handlers to get more confident with their dogs.

The new programs brought many new handlers in to our Association. I don't think it would be an exaggeration to say they injected new life into an old dog. I recently attended an Amateur trial with my pup. We had a lot of fun with lots of new handlers. I had to smile as I watched the nervous pacing and listened to the strategizing in the gallery. If you think it was any less intense in that Amateur trial than during a National Trial, you'd be mistaken. The handlers, and their spouses, were 100% in the moment, and it was great to see.






